My Day at Nature Explorers

When I come to Nature explorers I need to have on my long pants, shoes and socks. My long pants, shoes and socks help keep my feet and legs protected when I'm climbing and walking through the bush. I need to apply sunscreen and insect repellent so I am sunsafe and protected from insect bites.

I will have an ice pack in my lunchbox to keep my food cold when I am out exploring.



When I arrive at Nature explorers I find my name on my red hat and put it on.

Nature Explorer hats are red so that my teachers can see me easily. Red is a very visible colour especially in the bush. Wearing my red hat keeps me safe.



On site there are no fences so we use red ropes so we know where we can play. I don't go past the red ropes.



During my exploring day sometimes I will go on walks. My teachers will show me how to safely walk along the paths and cross the roads. Sometimes I will be playing at site or climbing trees and sometimes I will go onto the mat for group times.



During group times I need to use whole body listening. I will sit on the mat and be ready to listen to stories. If I want to ask a question I can keep my thought in my thought bubble and put my hand up so the teacher knows I have a thought.



If it is raining I will put on a red rain jacket and red rain pants to keep me dry.

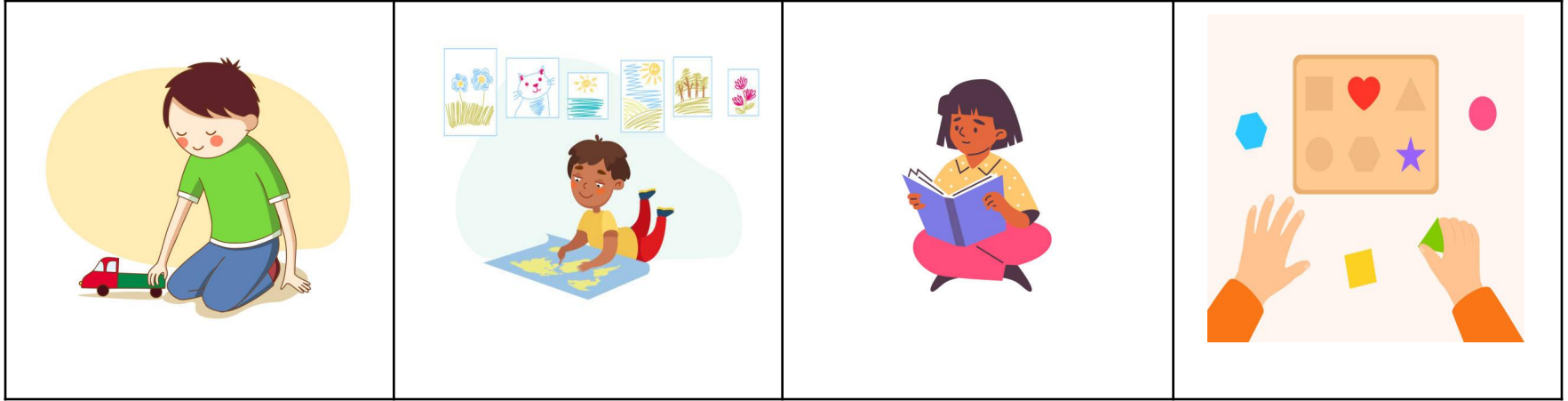
We will set up a shelter to play under out of the rain.
